Finally a huge congratulations to our Values Champions for showing everyone that belief, respect and friendship can be shown to both children and adults no matter what age you are.





### 7 questions to help you start a conversation with your child about online safety

THIS WILL GIVE YOU A GOOD OVERVIEW OF THE TYPES OF THINGS YOUR CHILDREN ARE DOING ON THEIR DEVICES, ALONG WITH THEIR INTERESTS. REMEMBER THAT TWEY MIGHT NOT TELL YOU EVERYTHING THEY ARE USING, SO IT IS A GOOD IDEA TO ASH THEM TO SHOW YOU THEIR DEVICE. BECAUSE NEW APPS AND GAMES ARE RELEASED REGULARLY, IT IS IMPORTANT TO HAVE THIS CONVERSATION OFTEN TO ENSURE YOU ARE UP TO DATE WITH WHAT THEY ARE DOING.

Which websites do you enjoy using and why?

AS IN THE TIP ABOVE. ASKING THIS QUESTION WILL ALLOW YOU TO FIND OUT WHAT YOUR Child is doing online, and encourage positive conversations about their online activity. Ask them how they use the websites, and take an interest in how they can use them in a positive way, also asking them to show you if possible.



PLRY RGRIND How does this game/app work?

Can I play?

SHOW A GENUINE INTEREST IN WHAT THEY ARE DOING, WHILST YOU ARE PLAYING A GAME OR USING AN APP WITH THEM, IT MIGHT HIGHLIGHT SOMETHING THAT THEY DON'T NECESSABILY THINK IS A DANGER TO THEM, IF THEY ACT LINE THEY DON'T WANT TO SHARE THEIR ACTIVITIES WITH YOU, QUESTION WHY.

#### Do you have any online friends?

CHILDREN CAN FORM POSITIVE RELATIONSHIPS WITH PEOPLE OBLINE, AND THIS HAS BECOME MORE COMMON THANKS TO OBLINE MULTI-PLAYER OPTIONS, BUT THEY MAY NOT FULLY UNDERSTAND THE OFFFERENCE BETWEEN A FRIEND AND A STRANGER YOU COULD MAHE THE DUESTION MORE SPECIFIC TO YOUR CHILD, FOR EXAMPLE: "HAYE YOU MET ANYONE OBLINE THAT YOU LINE TO PLAY GAMES WITH?" THEY MAY NOT WANT TO SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH YOU SO ENSURE YOU TEACH THEM ABOUT HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS.



Do you know where to go for help?



ALTHOUGH YOU MAY BE THE ADULT THEY TRUST THE MOST, SOME CHILDREN STRUGGLE TO TALM ABOUT WHAT HAPPENS ONLINE DUE TO CONFUSION OR EMBARASSMENT. BECAUSE OF THIS THEY MAY STRUGGLE TO APPROACH THE NORMAL PEOPLE WHO WOULD HELP. SUCH AS YOURSELF OR A TEACHER. HAVE A CHAT TO YOUR CHILD ABOUT EXACTLY WHERE THEY CAN GO FOR HELP. AND HOW THEY CAN REPORT ANY ACTIVITY THAT THEY BELIEVE IS IMAPPROPRIATE ONLINE.

Do you know what your personal information is?

YOUR CHILD MAY ALREADY HNOW WHAT THEIR PERSONAL INFORMATION IS BUT THEY MIGHT NOT THINK ABOUT HOW IT CAN BE SHARED. HAVE A CONVERSATION ABOUT WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION IS AND HOW THIS CAN AFFECT THEM IF IT IS SHARED BEYOND THE INTERDED RECIPIENT. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOUR CHILD UNDERSTANDS THE DANGERS OF SHARING CONTACT DETAILS OR PHOTUS, AS INFORMATION SUCH AS THIS CAN SPREAD QUICKLY ONLINE.



Do you know your limits?



CHEOREN MAY NOT UNDERSTAND THE NEGATIVE IMPACTS OF DEVICE OR GAME ADDICTION, TALK TO THEM OPENLY ABOUT HEALTHY HABITS AND ASH WHETHER OR NOT THE SPENDING TIME ONLINE OR PLAYING A GAME IS AFFECTING THEIR SLEEP, PERFORMANCE AT SCHOOL OR IF THEY ARE GENERALLY LOSING INTEREST IN OTHER ACTIVITIES, YOU MAY LEAD ON TO ENCOURAGING ALTERNATIVE ACTIVITIES AND DISCUSSING THE INTRODUCTION OF TIME LIMITS WHEN AT HOME.
